In January 2005, some stem cell transplant recipients and caregivers started discussing ways in which support could be given to the Provincial Blood and Marrow Transplant Program. these discussions. From Saskatchewan Stem Cell Transplant Advocacy Group or STEM was born. On June 16th, 2006 the organization incorporated under became Saskatchewan Non-Profit Corporations Act.

STEM activities are organized by a Board of Directors from around the province. The Board meets approximately once a month and highlights of these meetings, together with updates on the BMT Program, are reported in the STEM newsletter.
